You may require registering your sweepstake with your local council and may require an additional license. You can refer to the <u>Gambling Commission</u> for guidance.

Sweets in a jar

A great idea is to fill a jar with different sized sweets, allowing work colleagues or friends to guess how many are inside. The closest guess takes home the jar.

Sporty winners

Who'll win the Premier League, the Grand National or the Six Nations this year?



Reality TV

Are your friends or family avid fans of Strictly, Bake Off, or Eurovision? Get competitive while you watch by rooting for your entry.



- If required, print and cut out the names/teams involved in your sweepstake, (for example, the names of contestants on a show, or sports teams). Next, ask friends or colleagues to pick a name out of a hat. If your sweepstake involves people taking a guess, you're ready to get started!
- Reep a record of everyone's guesses on page 2 of this document
- At the end of the event or show finale, announce the winner, present them with a prize and make your donation to Bowel Cancer UK
